# c. Eco-Theatre Group & Earth Sprite Project (SF/DF)

# d. TerraCycle Project (DF)

# 8. Partnership Project: Godalming Climate Forum & Climate Hub for Godalming (DF/SF)

Alongside this GCF activity, there is a possibility that WN could become a Climate Hub for Godalming with the support of the Godalming Town Council (GTC).
